I would like to offer my comments regarding the United States Postal Service's area mail processing feasibility study that would move the Butte, Montana, Customer Service Mail Process Center to the Great Falls, Montana, Customer Service Mail Processing Facility.

Here are a few reasons I believe the elimination of the one-day mail service will negatively affect the community of Butte, southwest Montana, and the entire State of Montana.

- \* The elimination of the one-day mail service will affect all businesses in not only southwest Montana but across the state.
- \* The elimination of the one-day mail service will gravely affect our citizens who rely on that service to deliver their life-altering medicine.
- \* The elimination of the one-day mail service will affect our citizens who anxiously await the receipt of their checks or vouchers to feed their families.
